## RESOURCE CENTER

### Overview

The Resource Center (RC) maintains a comprehensive collection of alcohol, tobacco and other drug (ATOD) and problem gambling prevention and treatment information. Following is a brief description of services provided to California residents at no cost through the Information Clearinghouse, Lending Services, Conference Services, and Information Services. ### Information Clearinghouse

ATOD and problem gambling booklets, pamphlets, research papers, posters, technical manuals and other printed materials are available upon request. The Clearinghouse provides information to individuals, community and school organizations, prevention and treatment programs, and government agencies. Printed materials are continually updated as new information becomes available. The Clearinghouse has nearly 700 different publications, a few of which are available in other languages. ### Lending Services

Lending Services carries a collection of specialized ATOD reference sources including books, journals, reports and audiovisual materials. These materials are available for loan directly to employees of
