<p><b>Description of Technical Assistance/Training Services or Materials</b></p>	<p>This contract provides technical assistance and training to improve substance use disorder prevention, treatment and recovery services to California Native American communities. Under this contract, NAHC will conduct a statewide awareness campaign to expand substance use disorder service awareness in California's Native American women.</p> <p>The NAHC offers technical assistance and training to substance use disorder service providers on culturally appropriate prevention, treatment and recovery service delivery. The NAHC's pool of qualified Native American consultants offer technical assistance on a wide-range of substance use disorder service topics. Examples of technical assistance and training topics that may be covered include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• trauma informed approaches to substance use disorder service delivery;</li> <li>• understanding how Indigenous Traditional Knowledge Systems can improve substance use disorder service outcomes;</li> <li>• culture based prevention strategies; and</li> <li>• tools and protocol that enhance substance use disorder prevention, intervention, treatment and recovery support at the individual, family, clan and Tribe/community level.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Populations or Groups Served</b></p>	<p>California AOD service providers (both nonprofit and for profit/private providers, regardless of licensure or certification status), county AOD administration offices, coalitions or local groups, community-based programs, faith-based organizations, and state government agencies may apply for TA and training under this contract.</p>
<p><b>Eligibility Criteria</b></p>	<p>Non-fee services are available to urban or rural, tribal, Indian AOD programs, tribal courts, California county alcohol and drug programs and other entities providing services for substance use disorders.</p>
