<p>Description of Technical Assistance/Training Services or Materials</p>	<p>A top priority of the California Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) is to improve the accountability of the Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) treatment system in California in terms of ensuring quality services and effective client outcomes. UCLA and ADP have worked together over the last decade to evaluate and enhance data collected on AOD services and client outcomes across California. More recent work from 2009-2011 is in support of establishing a more effective AOD system as a continuum of services. The work plan will help ADP address the following four Objectives: Objective 1: Examine CalOMS Tx data to enhance AOD treatment services and client outcomes in California Objective 2: Enhance CalOMS Tx system to include performance measurement and outcome measurement in support of the Continuum of Services System Re-engineering (COSSR) Objective 3: Increase the capacity of AOD stakeholders (state ADP, county administrators and providers) to understand how to apply performance and outcome data to improving the quality of treatment services Objective 4: Prepare AOD prevention and recovery workforce as California prepares for health care reform through the Integration Learning Collaborative, CATES series and associated webinars and trainings</p>
